2 Examples of Determination to Keep Going

(JESUS) "I'm will KEEP ON driving out demons and healing people-today, and tomorrow, and on the third day I'll reach my goal. In any case, I MUST KEEP GOINGtoday, and tomorrow, and the next day." Luke 13:32-33 (NIV)

(PAUL) "We're hard pressed on every side by troubles, but we're not crushed and broken. We're perplexed, but we don't give up and quit. We're hunted down, but God never abandons us. We get knocked down, but we get up again AND KEEP GOING." 2 Corinthians 4:8-9 (NLT)

1. HONESTLY

GOD ALREADY KNOWS

• **GOD UNDERSTANDS** <u>!</u> "The Lord knows what's in everyone's mind AND <u>he understands</u> everything you think." 1 Chronicles 28:9 (NCV)

3. GRATEFULLY DESPITE ALL THAT'S BAD

"Give thanks IN all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."

1 Thessalonians 5:18 (NIV)

"(In grief) Job tore his robe and shaved his head. Then he fell to the ground and WORSHIPED GOD. He said, 'I was born with nothing, and I'll die with nothing. The Lord gave, and now he has taken away. May the name of the LORD BE PRAISED.' IN SPITE OF EVERYTHING that had happened, Job did not sin by blaming God."

Job 1:20-22 (GNT)

Job showed that I can always be grateful:

- That God is loving and cares for me Job 10:12
- That God had a detailed plan for my future Job 23:14
- That God is in control of what I don't understand Job 34:13
- That God will reward me after I'm tested Job 23:10

"Here I am in the place of worship, eyes open, drinking in your strength."

4. CONSTANTLY

"We must focus on Jesus, the source and goal of our faith. He saw the joy ahead of him, so he endured death on the cross and ignored the disgrace it brought him. Then he received the highest position in heaven." Hebrews 12:2 (GW)
