2. RELINQUISH

"Never avenge yourselves. Leave that to God, for he has said that he will repay those who deserve it." Romans 12:19 (TLB)

"Peter . . . asked, 'Lord, <u>how often</u> should I forgive someone who sins against me? Seven times?' 'No, not seven times,' Jesus replied, 'but seventy times seven!'" Matthew 18:21-22 (NLT)

3. RESPOND

"Do good to those who hate you, <u>bless</u> those who curse you, <u>pray for</u> those who mistreat you." Luke 6:27-28 (NIV)

4. REFOCUS

CRIMINALS GO UNPUNISHED
