1. ADMIT

Similarly, anyone who competes as an athlete does not receive the victor's crown except by competing according to the rules. The hardworking farmer should be the first to receive a share of the crops. Reflect on what I am saying, for the Lord will give you insight into all this." 2 Timothy 2:3-7 (NIV)

LESSONS FROM SPORTS

"In a race everyone runs, but only one person <u>gets first prize</u>. So run your <u>race to win</u>. To win the contest you must <u>deny yourselves many things that would keep you from doing your best</u>. An athlete goes to all this trouble just to win a blue ribbon or a silver cup, but we do it for a heavenly reward that never disappears. <u>So I run straight to the goal with purpose in every step</u>. I fight to win. I'm not just shadow-boxing or playing around. Like an athlete <u>I punish my body</u>, treating it roughly, training it to do what it should, not what it wants to. Otherwise I fear that after enlisting others for the race, I myself might be declared unfit and ordered to stand aside."

Then you will always have everything you need and plenty left over to share with others . . . For God is the one who provides seed for the farmer and then bread to eat. In the same way, he will provide and increase your resources and then produce a great harvest of generosity in you. Yes, you will be enriched in every way so that you can always be generous . . . For your generosity to them and to all believers will prove that you are obedient to the Good News of Christ."

WHAT HAPPENS EVERY TIME I GIVE: 12 BENEFITS

1. GENEROSITY

"They will give glory to God. For your generosity to them and to all believers will prove that you are obedient to the Good News of Christ."
