HOW TO HEAR GOD
Luke 8:4-15
"A farmer went out to sow his seed. As he was scattering the seed, <u>some fell along</u> the path; it was trampled on, and the birds ate it up." Luke 8:5 (NIV)
"Those along the path are the ones who hear, and then the devil comes and takes away the word from their hearts, so that they may not believe and be saved." Luke 8:12 (NIV
The hardened soil =
3 causes:

"Other seed fell on shallow soil with rock beneath. This seed began to grow, but

soon withered and died for lack of moisture." Luke 8:6 (TLB)

2.

The seeds on the rocky soil represent those who hear the message and receive the with joy. But since they don't have deep roots, they believe for a while, then they fall away when they face temptation." Luke 8:13 (NLT)
The shallow soil =
"Let us not give up the habit of meeting together Instead, let us encourage one another." Hebrews 10:25 (GNT)

3. "Other <u>seed fell in the weeds</u>; the weeds grew with it and strangled it."

Luke 8:7 (MSG)

"The seed that fell among thorns stands for those who hear, but as they go on their way they are choked by life's worries, riches and pleasures, and they do not mature." Luke 8:14 (NIV)

The soil with weeds = _____

"The seeds that fell in good soil stand for those who <u>hear</u> the message and <u>retain</u> it in a good and <u>obedient</u> heart, and they <u>persist</u> until they <u>bear fruit</u>."

SIX OF THE WAYS GOD SPEAKS

1. GOD SPEAKS THROUGH

"Everything in the Scriptures is God's Word. All of it is useful for teaching and helping people and for correcting them and showing them how to live."

2 Timothy 3:16 (CEV)

"Your Word is a lamp to guide me and a light for my path." Psalms 119:105 (GNT)

2. GOD SPEAKS THROUGH

"Christ chose some of us to be apostles, prophets, missionaries, pastors, and teachers, so his people would learn to serve and his body would grow strong."

Ephesians 4:11-12 (CEV)

"God in his kindness gave each of us different gifts. If your gift is <u>speaking what</u> God has revealed, make sure what you say agrees with the Christian faith."
