1.	COOPERATION: "The Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them two by two ahead of him to every town and place where he was about to go." Luke 10:1 (NIV) Who?
2.	"Do not take a purse." Luke 10:4 (NIV)
	"Do not take along any gold or silver or copper." Matthew 10:9 (BSB)
	"Take no money in your pockets." Mark 6:8 (NCV)
3.	SIMPLIFICATION: "Don't take a traveler's bag, nor an extra pair of sandals." Luke 10:4 (NLT) What distracts me?
4.	CONCENTRATION: "And don't stop to greet anyone on the road." Luke 10:4 (NLT)
5.	AFFIRMATION: "Whatever house you enter, begin by saying, 'Peace to this house.' If a man of peace is there, your peace will rest on him; if not, it will return to you." Luke 10:5-6 (BSB)
