#### TO BE A DISCIPLE OF JESUS I MUST . . .

1.

"If [they] want to be my disciples, tell them to come and follow me, for my servants must be where I am. And if they follow me, the Father will honor them."

John 12:26 (NLT)

"The plan was that they would <u>be with him,</u> and he would send them out to proclaim the Word." Mark 3:14 (MSG)

"Anyone who wants to be my follower <u>must love me</u> far more than he does his own father, mother, wife, children, brothers, or sisters—yes, more than his own life—otherwise he cannot be my disciple." Luke 14:26 (TLB)

"The most important commandment is this: . . . You  $\underline{\textit{must love the Lord}}$  your God with  $\underline{\textit{all}}$  your heart,  $\underline{\textit{all}}$  your soul,  $\underline{\textit{all}}$  your mind, and  $\underline{\textit{all}}$  your strength."
