ANYTIME I FACE PROBLEMS IN FAITH
• IT'S A
"For everyone here, including all the <u>soldiers</u> in the <u>palace guard</u> , knows that I am in chains <u>because of Christ</u> ." Philippians 1:13 (NLT)
• IT'S AN
"And because of my imprisonment, many of the <u>Christians</u> here have <u>gained</u> <u>confidence</u> and <u>become more bold</u> in telling others about Christ."

## CRITICS, COMRADES, COMPETITORS, & CONSPIRATORS:

"It's true that some preach Christ because they are <u>jealous and quarrelsome</u>. Others preach from <u>genuine good will. These do so out of love</u>, and they know God's given me the work of defending the gospel. Others preach Christ <u>insincerely</u> from a spirit of <u>selfish ambition</u>. Others just want to <u>stir up more trouble for me</u>, and add to my pain while I am in prison." Philippians 1:15-17 (GNT)

## PAUL'S ATTITUDE:

"But it doesn't really matter! The IMPORTANT THING is that in every way, whether for right or wrong reasons, the message of Christ is being shared! SO I am happy, and I will continue to be happy!" Philippians 1:18 (NCV)

"Be fearless, no matter who opposes you. It will be a sign to them of their downfall, that God is with you, and that he will save you." Philippians 1:28 (NIV/TLB)

"For you have been given <u>not only</u> the privilege of trusting in Christ but also <u>the privilege of suffering for him.</u> We are in this fight together. You have seen me <u>suffer for him</u> in the past, and you know that I am <u>still in the midst</u> of a great struggle."

Philippians 1:29-30 (NLT)

"I will continue to rejoice, <u>for I know</u> that as you pray for me and as the Spirit of Jesus Christ helps me, <u>all that's happened will all turn out for my deliverance.</u>"

Philippians 1:19 (NLT)

"It is my <u>eager expectation and hope</u> that I will not be at all ashamed, but that <u>with full courage</u>, now as always, Christ will be honored in my body, whether by life or by death!" Philippians 1:20 (ESV)

(vs. 21-25)

"If <u>by continuing to live I can do more worthwhile work for Christ</u>, then I am not sure which I should choose. I'm pulled in two directions! I want very much to <u>leave this life and be with Christ</u>, which is a far better thing; BUT <u>for your sake</u> it is much more important that I remain alive. I am sure of this, so I know that I will stay on with you all, so I can add <u>to your progress and joy</u> in the faith."
