Jacob's Example

Jacob *struggled* . . . with his brother with two wives with his in-laws with his 12 sons

Genesis 25:22, Hosea 12:3 Genesis 30:1-24 Genesis 31:1-2 Genesis 37-50

WE STRUGGLE

"I don't understand myself at all, for I really want to do what is right, but I don't do it. Instead, I do the very thing I hate . . . No matter which way I turn, I can't make myself do right. I want to, but I can't . . . But there is a <u>law at work within me that</u> is at war with my mind." Romans 7:15-23 (NLT)

• OUR REAL STRUGGLE

"As a man Jacob struggled with God." Hosea 12:3

JACOB'S WRESTLING MATCH

"Jacob sent his family across the Jabbok River but he stayed behind, alone. That night, a Man came and <u>wrestled with him</u> until daybreak. When the Man saw that he wasn't <u>winning the struggle</u>, he hit Jacob on the hip, and it was thrown out of joint. The Man said, 'Let me go; daylight is coming.' Jacob said, '<u>I WON'T LET GO</u> <u>UNTIL YOU BLESS ME</u>.' The Man asked '<u>What is your name?</u>' 'Jacob,' he replied. The man said, 'Your name will no longer be Jacob. <u>You have STRUGGLED WITH</u> <u>GOD</u> and with men, and <u>you have WON</u>; so <u>your name will be ISRAEL</u>.'

Jacob = "deceiver/manipulator" Israel = "struggled with God /Prince with God"

"Then God <u>blessed</u> him there. So Jacob called the place Peniel, saying, 'It is because I saw God face to face and yet my life was spared."" Genesis 32:23-30
