Example: Cain

Example: The Prodigal's Brother

"The older brother was so angry that he <u>would not go into the house</u>; so his father came out and begged him to come in." Luke 15:28 (GNT)

Example: The Pharisees

"The Pharisees and the teachers of the law were furious and <u>began to discuss</u> with one another what they might do to Jesus." Luke 6:11 (NIV)

HOW TO DISARM YOUR BUTTON-PUSHERS

"An angry person <u>causes trouble</u>; a person with a quick temper <u>sins a lot</u>." Proverbs 29:22 (NCV) "Hot tempers cause <u>arguments</u>." Proverbs 15:18 (GNT)

"Anger causes mistakes." Proverbs 14:29 (TLB)

"People with a hot temper do foolish things." Proverbs 14:17 (GNT)

"People with understanding control their anger; a hot temper shows great foolishness." Proverbs 14:29 (NLT)

"A person's wisdom yields patience; it is to one's glory to <u>overlook an offense</u>." Proverbs 19:11 (NIV)
